Competitors Briefing will be at **08:00hrs** (outside Rally HQ) & all Competitors **MUST** attend this briefing. Time for car 0 at MC1 will be **08:30hrs** (for your start time please add your car number to this time).

Please visit the following in order;

1. Noise Test – (You will receive your Process Card at this location and must keep it with you and get all the boxes signed before you complete signing on).
2. Wheel/Tyre Marking - This will be done before you enter Scrutineering. Please have your spare wheels loose in the boot ready to be marked. All wheels must be presented in a clean condition (this is for your benefit).
3. Scrutineering - Don't forget your spill kits and car documents.
4. Marshal's Signing On - Please read Marshals Signing On below (**Very Important**)
5. Competitors Signing On - 116 Membership cards will be issued at signing on.

Signing On Process

1. Club Membership Cards - If you are not currently a member of 116 Car Club, your Membership Card will be issued at Signing On.
2. Insurance Documents - Please have these documents with you, if using your own Insurance, **we require your Policy Number** – Your Insurance Cover is your responsibility and 116 Car Club **WILL NOT** inspect you Insurance documents
3. Any outstanding monies - **CASH ONLY ON THE DAY**
4. Rally packs will be issued after successful completion of the Signing On procedure (if only 1 of the crew has signed on then the Time Cards will be withheld until both crew members are fully signed on).

Any Competitor Not Signed On by 07:45hrs on Sunday 28th July may be refused a start and their place offered to a Reserve crew.

Time for Car 0 at MC1 is 08:30hrs (for your start time, please add your car number to this time).

MC1 location is shown on Test Diagram 1 – Glan-y-Gors 1

Due time of Car 0 at MC3 (Finish) is 14:45hrs.

Please Note – For the future use of our amazing test venues, PLEASE do not divulge any route or test venues on social media before MC1.

Any form of illegal servicing will not be tolerated on this event. Any crew caught abusing this rule along the route or at the lunch halt will be disqualified from the results and reported to Motorsport UK.

Anybody caught wheel spinning, testing handbrakes or doing donuts in the car parks at Glan-y-Gors will be refused a start and or disqualified from the results. CCTV cameras are installed at Glan-y-Gors watching you.

Marshals Signing On – VERY IMPORTANT

If your Marshal has already been asked to marshal at a test venue by a Test Commander or you/they have already phoned up and requested a marshal point from the Chief Marshal, then your Marshal doesn't need to attend Marshals Signing On at Glan-y-Gors on Saturday / Sunday and can go straight to their relevant test venue where they will Sign On with the Test Commander and be given their Marshal paperwork.

All other Marshals are to attend Marshals Signing On at Glan-y-Gors where they will be assigned a Test Venue.

All Marshals signing on for a competing crew **MUST** state which car number they are marshalling for on the Signing On sheet. **Please make sure your Marshal knows what car number you are.**

All this is very simple and easy to cheat you may think, BUT, if your Marshal hasn't signed on with the Test Commander and at his appointed location when the Chief Marshal drives the test then the competitors associated with that Marshal **WILL** be disqualified for the results.

We need 140 Marshals for this event and with a pool of 110 Marshals supplied by the Competitors it is up to you guys to make sure you all have a good day's motorsport.

So please help us to help you and request your Marshal attends their designated test for the duration of that test. We want all locations manned and we do not want to disqualify a crew due to a no show or early departure of their Marshal.

Please remind your Marshal to bring with them – High Viz Jacket, Clip Board, Pen, Map 116, Warm and Wet Clothing and Good Footwear.

Saturday Signing On

If you are attending proceedings on Saturday, then your marshal **MUST** be either with you to sign on or have booked a test venue with the Chief Marshal. Without the Chief Marshal's Stamp you will not be allowed to sign on and receive your rally pack.

7. Format

The total mileage will be 130 miles on the public highway with 25 miles held over 14 special tests

Enough fuel should be carried to cover 75 miles

Time has been allowed on the road section from Test Finish 8 to Test 9 for refuelling.

9. Awards

Add - Shaun Buckley Memorial Cup – This is a single award to the highest place driver whose home address is on map 116

Due to the unexpected low numbers in classes 4 & 5 only 1st & 2nd in Class will be awarded in each of those classes.

Class 4 – Historic Expert

Class 5 – Historic Novice

Team Award

If you want to enter a Team on the day please see the Team Entry Secretary at Signing On and complete the Entry Form – 3 Members per team (Maximum of 2 from each class, Historic classes to be classed as either Expert or Novice as per entry list) £5.00 each – Total £15.00. This is payable in cash on the day.

10. Entries

Delete - The maximum entry is 100, with 15 reserves.

Add - The maximum entry is 110, with 15 reserves.

Changing Car/Crew Details

If any changes are made to the Crew or Car details after the Finals have been issued or there is still information missing off the Final Seeded List, please inform Entry Secretary immediately so we can update the Entry List before the day to help with the smooth running at Signing On. At the very latest these details must be provided at Signing On.

Crews are reminded - A documentation fee of £15 will be deducted from any entry cancelled after the closing date for entries. Fees for accepted entries cancelled after 14th July 2019 will be refunded at the organisers' discretion.

12. Noise & Scrutineering

A reminder from the Environmental Scrutineer, if you damage your exhaust and it can't be repaired then please retire from the event so there are no future PR issues, plus it looks better on the results that you retired due to a broken exhaust rather than disqualified from results due to noise.

Please remember this event is run on a Road Rally Permit and NO in Car Cameras are allowed.

Any 'In Car' footage seen on social media by an official following the event will mean the crew will not be allowed to enter any further 116 Car Club events and will also be reported to the MSA for breach of R7.2.9.

16. Penalties

Delete E - Wrong side of a single cone or marker **1st +30 seconds / 2nd Test Maximum**

Add E - Wrong side of a single cone or marker **+30 seconds per offence**

Delete R - The wrong test penalty will be applied if you make a mistake on a test and pass the wrong side of a cone or go the wrong way around a cone. You may retrace your steps as long you are no more than 2 car lengths passed the manoeuvre. Once you have passed 2 car lengths incorrectly you will automatically incur the penalty for not performing a test correctly.

Add R – A Test Maximum will be applied if you take the incorrect route on a test or at a manoeuvre, e.g. wrong way through a chicane / slalom (You may retrace your steps as long you are no more than 2 car lengths passed the manoeuvre. Once you have passed 2 car lengths incorrectly you will automatically incur the penalty for not performing a test correctly).

18. Results

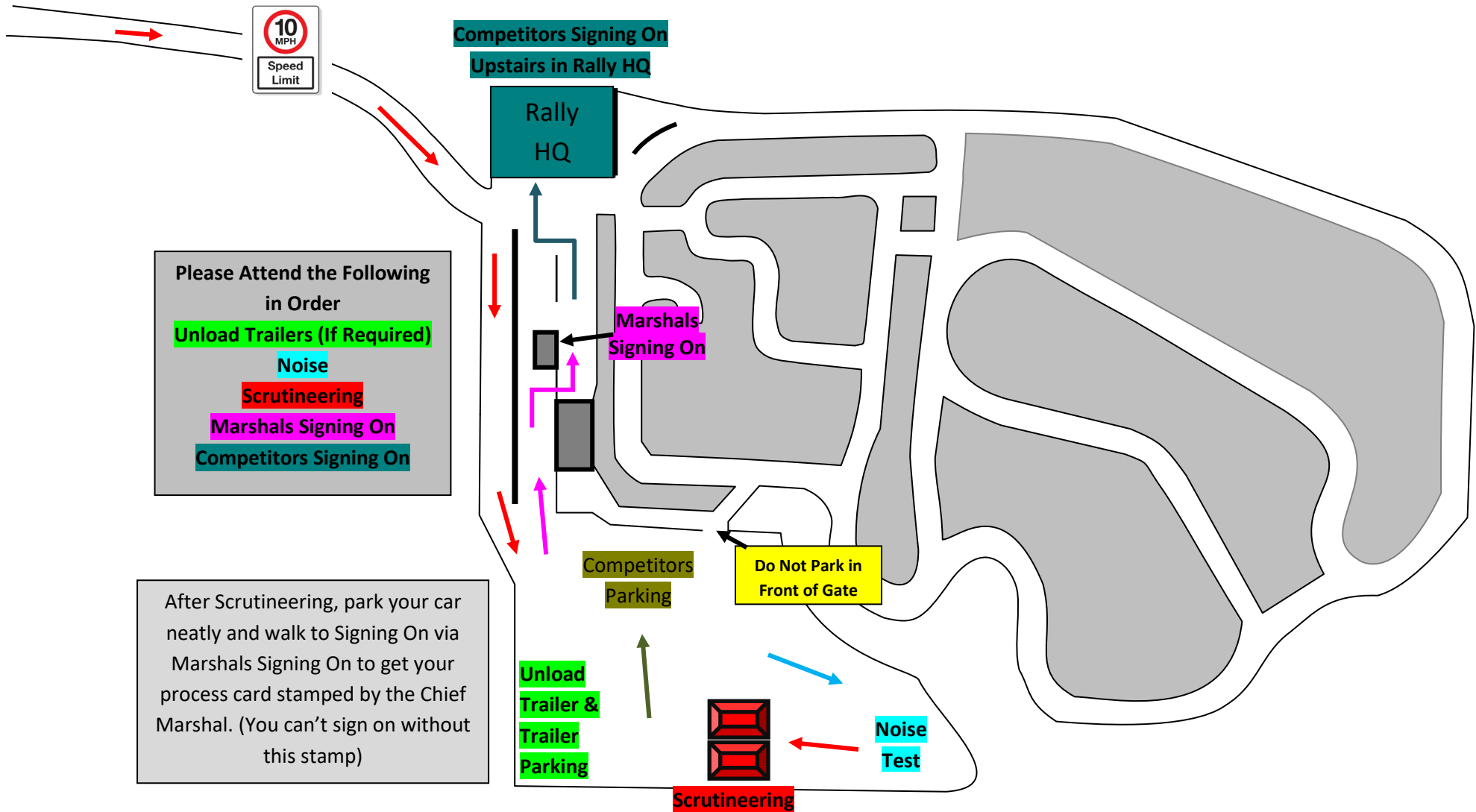

Helpful Hints on 116 Targa Timing

MAIN CONTROLS

These are the only controls on the rally where you are penalised for booking in early or over the Permitted Time Allowance of 15mins. (OTL 15mins)

On this event you are timed from MC1 to MC2, then MC2 to MC3.

TRANSPORT SECTIONS

These are the road sections between the test venues, normally held on the public highway and are timed to a low average speed of 20 to 25 mph where YOU MUST ABIDE BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT AND THE HIGHWAY CODE.

NO SPEEDING OR AGGRESSIVE DRIVING AND NO HARASSING HORSE RIDERS OR CYCLISTS

TIME CARDS

The timecard shows 'Your Schedule Time' and NOT 'Due Time of Car 0'.

The times shown in 'Your Schedule Time' is the time that YOU are due at each control.

A Time shown in **BOLD** is your due time at an MC.

A Time shown in (Brackets) is the advised time for you to start a test.

You can NOT be penalised for booking in early or late at a test start while the test is OPEN.

All Timecards show a different time in the 'Your Schedule Time' Column as they are based on your competition number. If you are car 35, then your time card will show you due at a control 35mins later than car 1

Car 0 Timecard for Test Start 1 shows 11: in the 'Your Schedule Time' column

Car 1 Timecard for Test Start 1 shows 11:01 in the 'Your Schedule Time' column

Car 32 Timecard for Test Start 1 shows 11:32 in the 'Your Schedule Time' column

DELAY ALLOWANCE

When you arrive at a Test Start there will more than likely be a small queue of cars waiting to start the test, DO NOT PANIC.

If there is a hold up on the test and you think you will be starting 3mins after your due time, simply walk up to the test start marshal and ask for a Delay Allowance. This time will then be added to your due time at the next MC, meaning you are not having to make that lost time back up by speeding on the public highway.
